November 16: New Oregon OSHA Provisions & Poster Requirements Go into Effect

As a reminder, Oregon OSHA recently published extensive temporary rules regarding COVID-19 workplace exposure that implicate all workplaces in Oregon. The following provisions go live Monday, November 16 for all workplaces:

- Physical distancing
- Mask, face covering, or face shield requirements
- Cleaning and sanitation efforts
- Developing a COVID-19 infection notification protocol a model policy released by Oregon OSHA can be found <u>here</u>.
- Posting Oregon OSHA's "COVID-19 Hazard Poster"
